## **Elisabeth Motsinger Sends Condolences on Passing of State Rep. Larry Brown**

(Winston-Salem, NC) Elisabeth Motsinger, 5<sup>th</sup> District candidate for Congress, reacted to the death early today of State Representative Larry Brown of Kernersville, saying, "I was saddened to hear of Larry Brown's death. I respect his commitment to public service and to representing the people of his district. He was a man of conviction who listened to those with opposing viewpoints. Our whole campaign has his family and friends in our thoughts and prayers during this difficult time."

Brown, a Republican, was completing his fourth term representing District 73. He also served Kernersville as an alderman for 11 years and as mayor for eight years. He was 69.

Elisabeth Motsinger is a physician assistant and a twice-elected member of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education. She completed her medical training at Wake Forest University, where she is completing a master's degree in bioethics. Motsinger is the mother of

three grown children. She and her husband, John, live in Walkertown and are active in their church community. In May, Motsinger won the Democratic primary with 70 percent of the vote. She faces Virginia Foxx in the November election.
